Summer Evening Event Bringsty Common near Bromyard

Orienteering in Worcester, Hereford, South Shropshire, Black Country and Birmingham.

Location

Bringsty Common is to the south of the A44 Worcester to Bromyard road, with access at

the Live & Let Live" pub sign some 6km east of Bromyard.

Landranger 149 Map ref: SO 698551.

Terrain:

The common comprises a comprehensive path network around and over a series of bracken colonised hills interspersed with small wooded areas. Planning will assume that routes taken will avoid accessing the areas of bracken. There are a considerable number of properties dotted around the common, and all garden areas will be out of

bounds.

Map:

A4 sized 1:7,500 scale map prepared March 2023 by Brian Hughes. Printed on non-waterproof paper so please bring a transparent map bag. Control descriptions in loose text format. The A44 will not be crossed.

Course & Scoring:

A 60 minute score event penalised at the rate of 10 points per minute / 1 point per 6 seconds over the one hour time limit. Controls must be taken in numerical order, but controls may be missed where appropriate. eg. 1,2,3,7.8,11, 12 is OK but

1,2,3,8,6,4,5,11,12 is not. Scoring by SI Card. Hire cards available.

The Live at Whitbourne - just 5 minutes away. Head towards Worcester and at the bottom of the hill turn left at the offwhite, closed, Wheatsheaf pub towards

Whitbourne. The pub is then around 1km on the right.

In order that we can give the pub a rough idea of numbers it would be helpful if, when reerving a map, you could indicate if you are likely to eat at the pub after the event.
